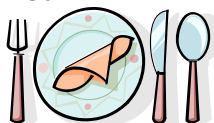

Sheena Gabriel is away on ministerial retreat from 9—12 November

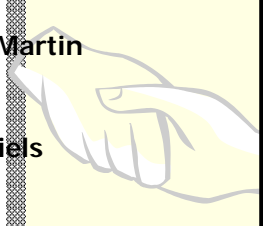

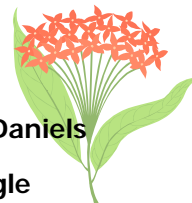

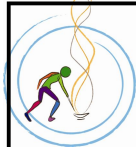
