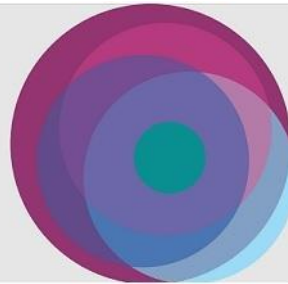

## **SOCIAL ACTION - CHRISTMAS PROJECT -**



The Trustees, with support from our minister, Martin, have designated **26 November as Social Action Sunday** - the time when we specifically think of others beyond our congregation and take action to support them.

Last year, we chose **Godalming & Villages Community Store** - our local referral-only food bank - and through your generous donations we raised enough money to provide hampers of Christmas treats for everyone on their books.

We wish to support the Community Store again, to help bring a little joy in these difficult times to those in need in our neighbourhood. One recipient last year broke into tears when presented with a hamper at the Store. Another said later that she hadn't had much to put under the tree so she placed the hamper there, and they enjoyed opening it together on Christmas morning.

It costs £5 for a hamper for a single person; £10 for a couple; and £20 for a family. At present, the Store is planning for 25 hampers of each type, to be on the safe side in case of new referrals.
